



E-mail links have all been updated to reflect the change in community council members.






There were two successful applications with a little left in the fund to carry over to next year. Formal letters to be sent out.




Planning Applications



Aberdeenshire Council doesn't check for breaches of planning applications and rely on the public to raise concerns.




