This survey refers specifically to the section from Inverbervie to Stonehaven. Your feedback will help shape plans for creating and improving the path, protecting the natural environment and also to help us to apply for funding to carry out the work.

Distance - 22km.

Elevation - 780m.

Walking Time - 7 Hours.

Heritage Highlights - Inverbervie Heritage including Castle, closed railway and jute industry. Kinneff Church and Dunnottar Castle with their historical link to the Honours of Scotland. Todhead Lighthouse. Catterline Harbour and Artists Heritage, i.e. Joan Eardley. Stonehaven Seaside Tourist Town, also including sculpture trail and Harbour.

N.B. There is not a formal route established throughout the majority of the coast. There is a risk to life from landslides and steep drops and great care should be taken if you decide to walk this route. It is entirely at your own risk. We are working with RSPB and local landowners to improve this route.
